

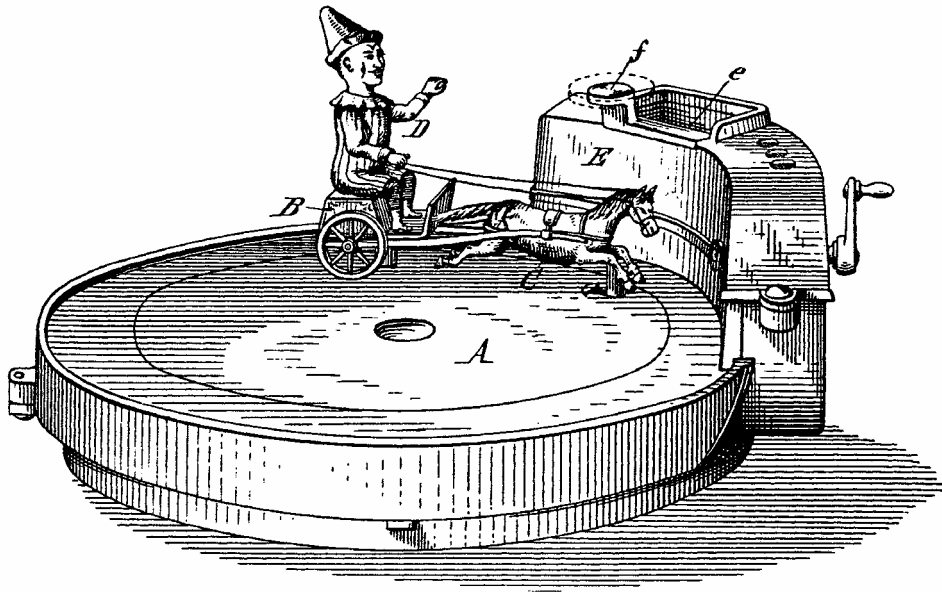

DESIGN FOR A TOY SAVINGS-BANK.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 18,618, dated September 18, 1888.

Application filed August 13, 1888. Serial No. 222,660. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, CHARLES G. SHEPARD and PETER ADAMS, of the city of Buffalo, in the county of Erie and State of New York, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Toy Savings-Banks, of which the following is a specification.

This design relates to the general configuration of an ornamental toy savings-bank, which is clearly represented in the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification.

A represents the circular base of the savings-bank, representing a circus-ring or race-course.

B represents a miniature cart resting on the circular base A, and C represents the figure of a horse or other animal attached to the cart.

D represents a human figure seated in the cart, and represented as holding the reins of the animal in its right hand and as having its left arm elevated.

E represents a wall or raised portion rising from one side of the circular base A. In the top of the wall E is an opening, *e*, and in front of this opening is a shelf, *f*.

We claim as our invention—

The design for a toy savings bank herein shown and described, consisting of a base, a cart resting on said base, the figure of an animal attached to said cart, a figure seated in the cart, and a wall or elevated portion rising from said base, substantially as set forth.
