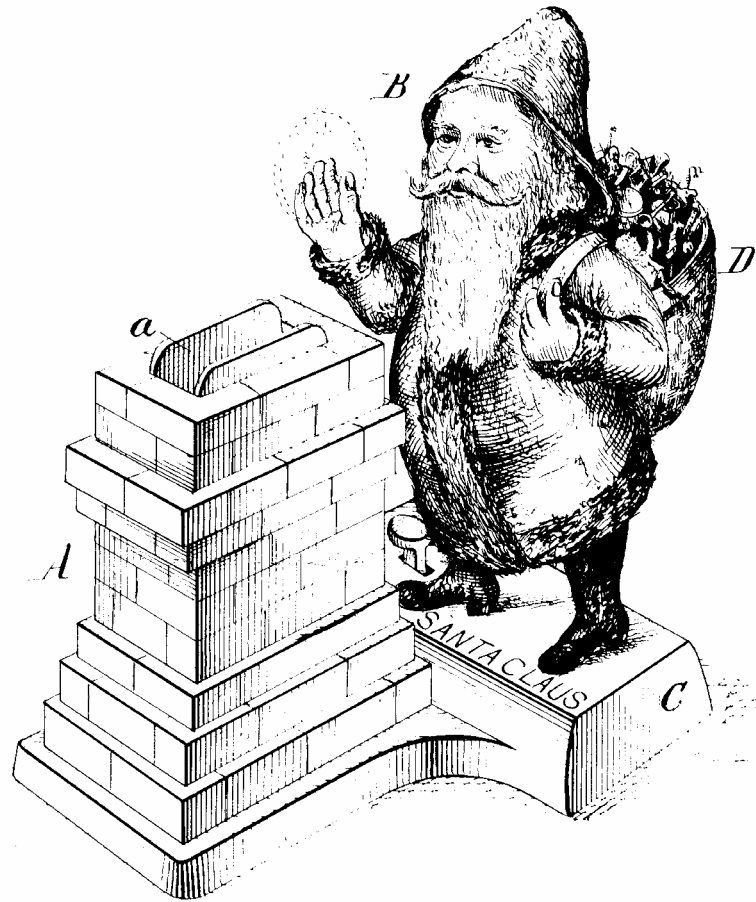

## DESIGN FOR A TOY SAVINGS-BANK.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 19,356, dated October 15, 1889.

Application filed August 12, 1889. Serial No. 320,506. Term of patent 7 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that we, CHARLES G. SHEPARD  
and PETER ADAMS, citizens of the United  
States, residing at Buffalo, in the county of  
5 Erie and State of New York, have invented  
and produced a new and original Design for  
Toy Savings-Banks, of which the following is  
a specification.

This design relates to the general configu-  
10 ration or form of an ornamental toy savings-  
bank; and it consists of the representation  
of a miniature chimney and a figure repre-  
senting "Santa Claus" standing near said  
chimney.

15 Our novel design is clearly represented in  
the accompanying drawing, forming part of  
this specification.

A represents the chimney, forming the  
20 body of the bank and having an opening  $\alpha$   
in its top.

B represents a figure representing Santa  
Claus standing upon a base C near said  
chimney and having one hand raised above  
the top of the chimney.

D represents a basket or bundle of toys 25  
strapped upon the back of the figure.

We claim as our invention—

The design for a toy savings-bank herein  
shown and described, the same comprising a  
base, a chimney, and a figure representing 30  
Santa Claus standing near said chimney,  
substantially as set forth.
