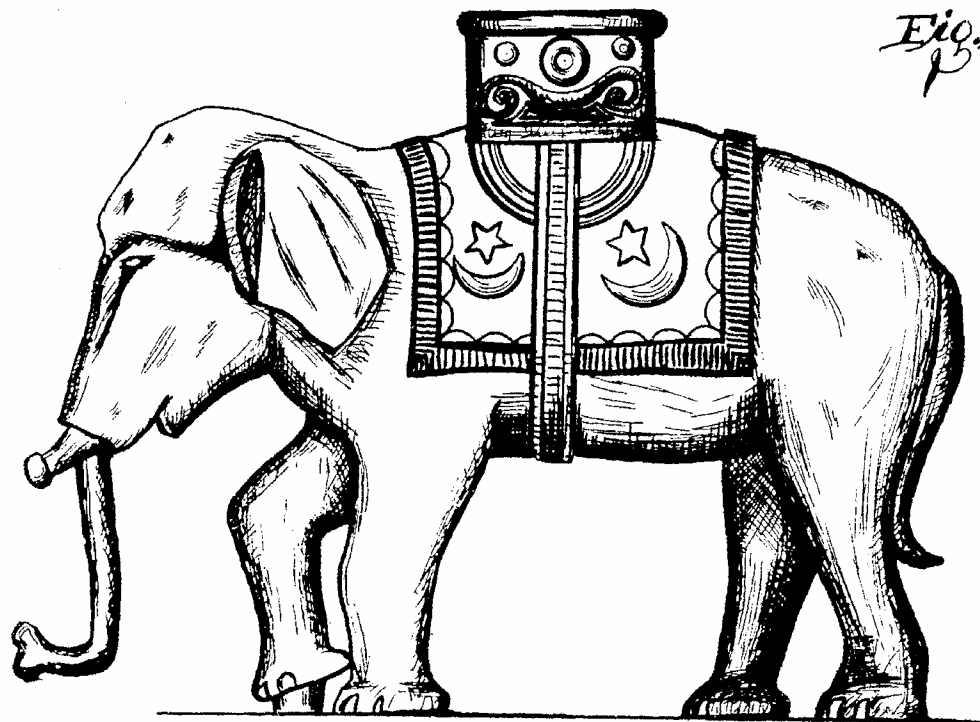

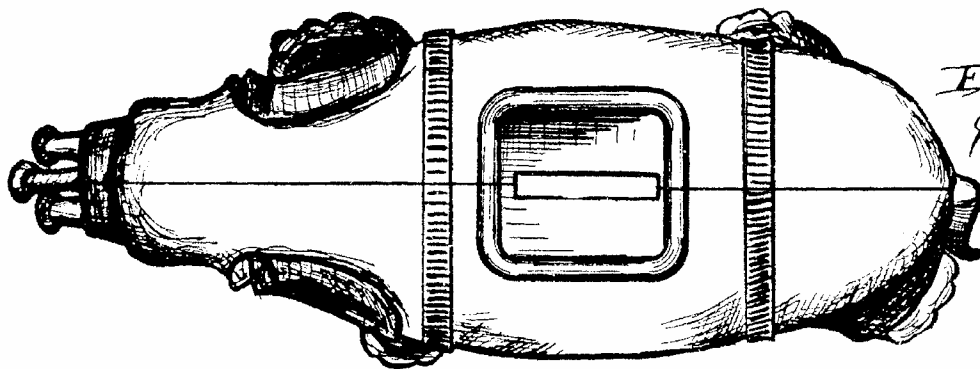

DESIGN FOR A TOY BANK.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 37,474, dated June 27, 1905.

Application filed May 15, 1905. Serial No. 260,591. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ADAM C. WILLIAMS, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Ravenna, in the county of Portage and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Toy Bank, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.
